- In extraordinary circumstances the Board meets more frequently
- Library operations are the responsibility of the Library Director and staff. Trustees are a governance board our focus is on financial oversight, policy, and ensuring that the library meets its legal obligations.
- Being a Library Trustee is a volunteer position and is not compensated.

If you are interested in joining our Library Board please fill out a nomination form by end of day on June 5^{th.} We welcome nominations and self-nominations from individuals who are eager to contribute their time and talents to our library. Elections to the Board of Trustees will take place at the Annual General Meeting on June 10, 2024 at 6pm. Candidates should be in attendance.
